

Deadline to Apply to "Reproducible Research Practices for Arctic Research Using R" in October 31st!

We are writing to send out a reminder that the deadline to <u>apply to our data</u> <u>management workshop</u> is this coming Monday, October 31st. This course is for Arctic researchers, and there is no cost for participants to attend.

This 5-day remote workshop will provide researchers with an **overview of best data management practices, data science tools for cleaning and analyzing data,** and concrete steps and methods for more easily documenting and preserving their data at the Arctic Data Center.



Topics include:

- Literate analysis (RMarkdown),
- data wrangling (tidyr/dplyr),
- data publishing,
- visualization (ggplot2/sf),
- code versioning (git),
- ethical data procedures (CARE principles)

This course is for Arctic researchers who have moderate programming experience (R preferred) and an interest in gaining practical skills in reproducible research techniques.
